#### A Vision for Ward 8 and Hamilton

- Safe and Accessible Transportation: We must address the inadequacies of accessible cabs, public transit, and paratransit services to meet the needs of all residents, including seniors and individuals with disabilities. A strengths-based approach is needed to ensure transportation equity across the city.
- Roadway and Pedestrian Safety: Investing in well-maintained roads, safer

  urgent action to expand affordable and accessible housing options to meet the growing
  needs of Hamiltonians.
- Accountability in City Spending: Taxpayer money must be used effectively. Too
  often, resources are wasted due to poor planning and costly do-overs. I am committed to
  ensuring fiscal responsibility and strategic investment in our city's future.
- Inclusive Recreation and Parks: The current administration has planned an accessible swing for Ward 8 this summer—an initiative I wholeheartedly support. However, we need to ensure that accessible play structures and recreational opportunities exist in all parks citywide.
- Inclusive Policy Making We must create policies that are inclusive and ensure decisions are made at the table in advance, adopting an enhanced approach to diversity. Having voices heard and implementing action plans from the start to reduce retrofit.

Representation matters. I will be a voice for those who often go unheard. My goal is not only to be present at the decision-making table but to ensure that every resident of Ward 8 is heard and valued. Leadership is about accountability—demonstrating it first and then expecting it from others.
